

Year 1 Autumn Term 1 2024



English and Reading

Our class text will be 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea', 'Where the Wild Things Are', 'Beegu' and 'Room on the Broom.' We will be reading the stories and using different skills to create a piece of writing linking to other areas of the curriculum.

Our writing focusses this half term:

- Character Description
- Shopping List

While also completing continuous provision alongside.

Maths

In Maths, we will be consolidating arithmetic skills and applying our skills into reasoning and problem solving questions. We will be studying:

- Place Value within 10
- Addition and subtraction within 10
- Shape



PSHCE

We will continue using jigsaw where we will be focusing on being me in my world. Who am I and how do I fit?



Music

Pupils will learn to sing a range of simple nursery rhymes. Pupils will join in with singing and reflect on how this makes them feel. They will be introduced to simple conducting cues and learn the terms melody and lyrics.

History

We will be studying changes within living memory. What do I know about my local area and myself.

We will be looking into how we grow and change.



Science

We will be studying seasonal changes throughout the year and plants including trees. We will be covering what are the parts of a plant, what are wild plants and where we find them.

We will be looking at the 4 seasons and the weather within those.

Art

Pupils will be introduced to a range of drawing tools, such as charcoal, pencil, chalk and pastel. They will be taught to make basic marks and about how changing the pressure and orientation of these marks can create different textures.

Design Technology

Design and Technology will be our focus in Autumn 2.

Computing

We will be learning to understand what technology is and developing mouse skills.

In PE this half term, we will be learning fundamental skills.
