
Our writing focusses this half term:

- Sentence structure
- Use of coordinating and subordinating conjunctions

 - Recounts



In Maths, we will be consolidating and building upon our number and place value knowledge before moving on to the four operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will master skills and techniques before applying those skills into reasoning and problem solving questions. We will be studying:

- Number and Place Value
- Addition & Subtraction
- Multiplication & Division





History

We will be investigating artefacts that show us what life was like during pre-historical times. We will be using timelines to plot events in chronological order and investigating key changes that occurred in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age.

Science

We will be studying rocks, soils and fossils and our key scientist for this half term will be Anjana Khatwa. We will find out how different types of rocks were made and their different properties. We will look at different types of soil and their composition. We will explore a range of fossils developing an understanding of where they are found, how they were formed and what they can show us about the past.

Art

We will be developing our drawing, painting and printmaking skills and studying successful artists within these fields to apply proven techniques to our finished pieces.

Computing

We will learn about computing systems and networks, exploring digital devices and understanding how they are connected.
